Permit Conditions:

The applicant's signature above is a written agreement to comply with the following conditions of the permit:

- (1) That the materials used in the construction of floats used in any parade shall be fire-retardant materials and shall be subject to such requirements concerning the fire safety as may be determined by the fire chief;
- (2) That permittee advise all participants in the parade or motorcade either orally or by written notice, of the terms and conditions of the permit, prior to the commencement of such parade or motorcade;
- (3) That no participant in a parade shall toss or throw any toys, candy, or other objects from a vehicle;
- (4) That the parade or motorcade shall continue to move at a fixed rate of speed and that any delay or stopping of said parade or motorcade, except when reasonably required for the safe and orderly conduct of the parade or motorcade, shall constitute a violation of the permit, and;
- (5) Such other requirements as are found by the Recreations Director to be reasonably necessary for the protection of persons or property: _____
