SUMMARY

City Council will approve the use of CARES Act Funding to establish a Utility Assistance Program for Socorro residents and enter into a service agreement totaling \$16,000 with the Lower Valley Water District.

STATEMENT OF THE ISSUE

The use of CARES Act funding for utility assistance programs is an eligible expense. There are a minimum of 33 households that have applied for utility assistance through Project Bravo, but have not received assistance due to a lack of funding. The El Paso County General Assistance Office also provides utility assistance but does not have funding to assist these residents at the moment. The COVID-19 Utility Assistance Program will assist Socorro residents who are eligible to receive utility assistance but have not been able to receive assistance due to lack of funds.

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Service Agreement

I. Overview

The purpose of the COVID-19 Water Assistance Program is to assist eligible low-income and COVID-impacted households with their water service bills including fees as part of the regular monthly bill.

For the purpose of this Service Agreement, a Water Provider is defined as a provider or conveyor of water service that furnishes water service to more than one customer certified by the Public Utility Commission of Texas.

The Water Provider (or "Vendor") agrees to honor the purpose of the COVID-19 Water Assistance Program and to administer funding provided by the City of Socorro (the "City") only for certified customers to whom Vendor continues to provide water services. The Water Assistance Provider agrees to make payments only for eligible low-income and COVID-impacted clients.

II. Agreement

III. Disclosures

The City named above represents and warrants to Vendor that it is a sub-recipient of the CARES Act Funding and as such is authorized to provide bill payment assistance service for eligible low-income households.

The Vendor named above is a Water Provider certified by the Public Utility Commission of Texas and represents and warrants that it is authorized to receive payments from City on behalf of a customer that has been determined to be eligible under the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) guidelines and as such is a "Certified Customer".

IV. Deliverables

- A. Vendor will, with reference to Certified Customer:
 - 1. Provide a list of program-eligible Certified Customers who have been determined to be eligible pursuant to the funding guidelines to the City.
 - 2. Provide documentation and records related to Certified Customer eligibility, and all financial backup to the City.
 - 3. Continue or restore water service to Certified Customer with no increases in charges, service charges, or other charges, affecting the total cost of the bill, except as allowed by the Public Utility Commission of Texas (the "PUCT").
 - 4. Invoice the Certified Customer in accordance with Vendor's normal billing practices.
 - 5. Not discriminate against Certified Customer in price or services, including the availability of deferred payment plans, level or average payment plans, discount, budget, advance payment or other credit plans.
 - 6. Rates offered to Certified Customer must be in accordance with the current approved tariffs by the PUCT.
 - 7. Not refuse to provide water service or otherwise discriminate in the marketing and provision of water service to any Certified Customer because of race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, sex, marital status, lawful source of income, level of income, disability, financial status, locations of customer in an economically distressed geographic area, or qualification for low-income services.
 - 8. In the event that the Certified Customer no longer resides where the water utility is serviced or if the water assistance pledge is not utilized for other reasons, the Vendor agrees to return all funds to the City in the form of a reimbursement check with Certified Customer/s payment detail provided. The City will not accept credits for unused water assistance funds.

B. The City will:

1. Provide payment to the vendor in one lump sum of up to \$\sum_{16,000}\$, for all Certified Customers who are residents of Socorro, Texas that are eligible for the program, up to the amount indicated herein.

V. Authorization

The terms of any confidential transaction under this Agreement or any other information exchanged by the City and Vendor relating to any transaction shall not be disclosed to any person

not employed or retained by the City or Vendor, their affiliates, or brokers, except to the extent disclosure is (1) required by law; (2) is permitted by written consent of the other party; or (3) is information which is or has been previously published, or becomes publicly known through no action of the City or the Vendor.
