
Good morning:

Below is the COVID data to be issued today.

Fortunately there are no deaths to report today. The current number of deaths remains at 554.

We will be reporting <u>838</u> new cases; and, staff will also be reporting <u>16 additional cases</u> which are part of the delayed local results issued by the State to the Department of Public Health. The results are from the tests conducted during the CDC Weeks 29, 41 and 42. We are currently in CDC Week 42. Staff will work to retroactively place the data in the appropriate week.

Health officials advised that 23,387 individuals have recovered from COVID-19. There are 7,399 active cases.



We will be reporting a cumulative testing total of 346,540. Our cumulative positivity rate is currently about 9 percent and our rolling 7-day average positivity is about 13 percent.
