

- Peer benchmarking with similar communities


# Demand-based assessment

- for all residents Focus on providing safe, secure, and accessible parks
- Concern for lack of maintenance and declining quality of older park amenities
- Improvements requested included:
- Site lighting
- Replacement of play equipment and other worn down amenities
- Concrete walking and biking trails
- Neighborhood sidewalks
- New parks in underserved areas

# Standards-based assessment


- Currently provide 46 acres of parks, compared to 214 acres per park standards and current
- New neighborhood and community parks need to access to park amenities population be developed in the south to provide equitable
