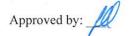

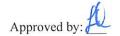

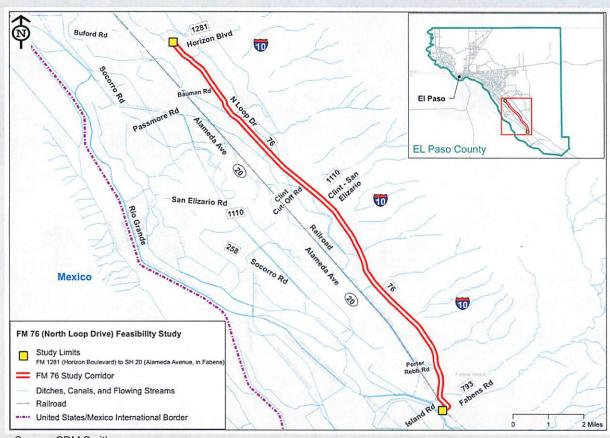

Beginning Corridor Cross Section: Four lanes with median for the initial length of 0.2-miles between FM 1281 (Horizon Boulevard) and Milo Drive, with 11-foot-wide paved shoulder on both sides and 5-foot-wide sidewalks available on both sides of corridor.



Ending Corridor Cross Section: Two lanes along FM 76 in the Town of Fabens, with 5-foot-wide sidewalks along Fabens Road, up until SH 20 (Alameda Avenue).

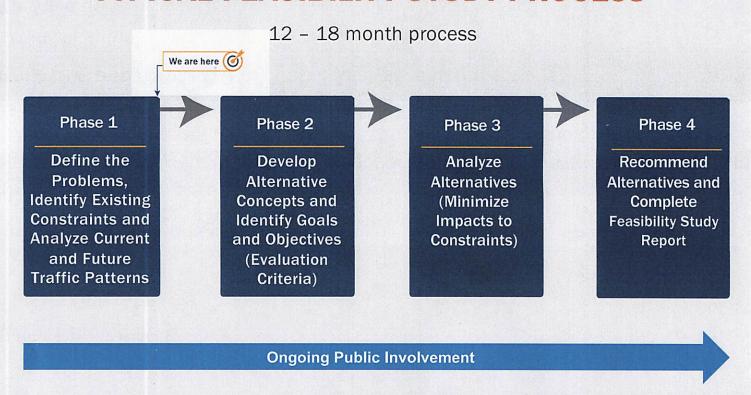

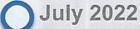
TYPICAL FEASIBILITY STUDY PROCESS



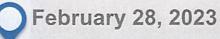
